Closed Session Minutes

The Madison County Board of Commissioners met in closed session on Tuesday, April 12, 2016 at A-B Tech, Madison Campus, Marshall, NC.

In attendance were Chairman Wayne Brigman, Vice-Chair Norris Gentry, Commissioner Bill Briggs, Commissioner Clayton Rice, Commissioner Matt Wechtel, County Manager Forrest Gilliam, Attorney Donny Law, and Clerk Darlyne Rhinehart.

The board met with Sheriff Buddy Harwood, and Michael Garrison, Chief of the Mars Hill Police Department to discuss the telephone system currently used by the Sheriff's Office, Emergency Management and the Finance Office.

The board met with Tammy Cody, Deputy Health Director, to discuss applications received for the position of CC4C Care Manager within her department. Mrs. Cody also discussed a vacant dental assistant position.
